The Education Department of the European Trade Union Institute, in cooperation with CISL and UGT-E, organises a training activity on "**Quality jobs for the green transition**" from **10 to 12 June 2025** in Florence, Italy.

Objectives

The transition from "brown" industries to "green" production will lead to the creation of new jobs, often referred to as "green jobs," while also destroying existing jobs. The key question is: How can we ensure that this transition does not come at the expense of workers' conditions and rights? How do we avoid the risk of precarity and insecurity due to the transition to green jobs? How can we ensure that the new jobs created are of high quality?

This training will address these critical questions by examining the importance of worker representation and collective bargaining as essential tools to secure quality jobs in emerging industries and services.

- Analysing the impacts of the green transition on jobs across various sectors (e.g., working conditions, salaries, health and safety)

- Assessing "quality jobs" using the European Job Quality Index (JQI) developed by the ETUI

- Sharing best practices in collective bargaining and worker representation within transitioning sectors

- Strengthening the role of trade unions and collective bargaining to enhance the quality of green jobs
