The Education Department of the European Trade Union Institute is organising a new training for **Eurotrainers** + . The course will take place from **18-21st of November 2025** in **Brussels, Belgium.**

This new training course is a continuation of the Eurotrainers' pathway, designed to meet the evolving training needs of European Trade Union trainers. As the training landscape continues to change, so too must the strategies and methods that trainers apply in diverse learning environments. This training will examine a range of emerging topics to such as facilitation, intercultural communication, emotional competences and the application of collective intelligence strategies to enhance group engagement and learning outcomes. Trainers will experiment with new tools and techniques, reflect on their own practice and collaborate with peers to co-create resources that can be applied within their own organisations.

Aims

- ✓ **Develop** a shared vocabulary related to European Trade Union training by actively exchanging experiences and co-creating common definitions;
- ✓ Analyze group dynamics by identifying stages of group development, diversity factors, inclusion strategies, and conflict resolution techniques to support multicultural group growth;
- ✓ **Identify key elements** of collective intelligence and **demonstrate** strategies to foster group emotional climates, enhancing collaboration and learning outcomes;
- ✓ **Apply** active facilitation techniques and digital tools to engage and motivate diverse groups in trade union training contexts.
